Sea Glass Lights by Leslie Connell



The pounding surf along the Maine coastline is a sight everyone should see and feel.
The never ending thunderous crashes on the shore.
The silent retreat back to sea.
It's nature's purest expression of comfort, calm, awe and wonder.
If only it could be bottled ...

My sea glass lights capture this experience in found objects of exquisite beauty. Each electrified art piece is a unique curiosity, that brings the power and majesty of the Maine coastline to your home.

ILLUMINATION – SEA GLASS LIGHTS

My sea glass lights, created in vintage jars, are individual expressions of the beauty of Maine sea glass, shells and found objects. I collect as much as I can from the shore and supplement scarce colors such as olive, blue and red with recycled glass tumbled to smooth the edges and give a frosted appearance.

By adding pieces of broken pottery, new life is brought to what may have been thrown away. Authentic local shells and rocks represent the bit of Maine coastline that is found in each lamp. The combination of the sea glass, pottery and natural elements provides interesting textures and color.

Finally, the ingredients are artistically composed in an antique jar and illuminated. Each light is a unique work of art.





INSPIRATION

I've always been the happiest when near the water. As a child, my sister and I hunted for treasures on the beach – an activity I never outgrew. Now, my treasure seeking takes me to Pleasant Island, the family island that's a 20-minute steam by lobster boat from the mainland.

During the summer I try to spend as much time there as possible – digging for clams, watching the lobster boats come and go through the Mussel Ridge Channel and combing the beach for treasures. The island inspired me to design and create my unique sea glass lights, capturing the essence of my island coastline in a lovingly crafted handmade creation to bring you the color and texture of my seaside family home.

Each lamp Comes with a 6' white cord with switch 4' from plug, candelabra socket, 7 1/2 watt bulb. 18 gauge wire. Lights are for household use only.
